CANTERBURY ROAD, ETCHINGHILL

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2) as amended by
The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council gives notice that Canterbury Road, Etchinghill will be closed to through traffic, on 15th September 2017 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Beachborough and Teddars Leas Road.

The alternative route is via A20 Ashford Road, Sandling Road and vice versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hours and 16:00 hours.

The closure is necessary to enable urgent carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site, and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
