TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2) as amended by
The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council gives notice that Vicarage Lane, Elham will be closed to through traffic, on 10th April 2017 for up to 5 days.

The road will be closed between the junction of New Road and in the vicinity of High Beeches.

The alternative route is via Vicarage Lane, Lickpot Hill, Oak Hill, Beresforstal Hill, Canterbury Road and New Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hrs and 16:00 hrs.

The closure is necessary to enable water pipe repairs to be carried out by Affinity Water South East.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site, and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
