Margaret Saunders' Meanderings

This morning dawned bright but frosty and with Autumn well advanced, nature's colours are rich and bright. It is the perfect day for visiting Nostel Priory in West Yorkshire which is now in the care of the National Trust. The house was built in the 18th century by the Winn family, replacing an older house. The design of this newer house is symmetrical and relatively plain in a style known as Palladianism, which was thought to express order and stability. It's original name was Nostel, Priory being added in the 19th century, referring back to the Augustinian monastery that had been on the site until the Dissolution of the Monasteries in 1540.

But it is not for the house that I visit Nostel Priory today. It is for a walk amongst its grounds, which are alive with the final flourish of colour that this season offers, before nature goes into hibernation for the colder Winter months, when colours are more muted

save for the brightness of berries. So I set off to explore. The rose garden, so full in the Summer months, is now stark -

the bushes having been pruned, the beds cleared of weeds and then finally manured. Similarly, the lavender bushes have been cut back. In the kitchen garden a gardener is planting out differing varieties of garlic in methodical lines. Everywhere in this area the soil is a rich dark chocolate brown, tilled and fed ready for next year's Spring growth, giving plants the best opportunity to grow and thrive.

I move back into the general parkland and follow a footpath. Low Winter light dances through a few remaining leaves on a mature tree, lighting them up making each one glow gold. Squirrels scurry and scamper through the fallen leaves, searching for the food that nature has dropped from the trees. Canada geese move in line, side by side, across the grass, methodically and systematically pecking for roots, grass, leaves and seeds, contentedly emitting muffled honking as they glean. Birds flutter through the trees. Interspersed amongst the deciduous trees are tall and full holly trees in Christmas tree shapes, teeming with red berries as if already dressed for the festive season, their glossy dark green leaves a perfect foil for their rich and ripe shiny fruit. 'Shushing' through dry leaves as I walk, I enjoy the sound they make and the shapes that indicate from which trees they have fallen.

To my left is an elegant arched bridge spanning the huge lake that surrounds the park and through the trees I can see glimpses of water, blue from the reflection of the sky. Standing still I absorb the silence, save for the slight rustle of leaves and the faint honking of the geese, letting my eyes feast on nature's glorious Autumn display. Moving

on, I walk down a slope between tall tree trunks, their elongated shadows stretching the length of the path. Long seedpods hang from a tree that I cannot identify. The still blue water of the lake perfectly reflects the further shoreline, seen through the skeletal branches of nearer trees. Close to me a patch of teasels makes striking silhouette shapes against the clear blue of the sky.

I can see why the Winn family chose this site to build a prestigious house, making a statement about their success and also why the Augustinians first used the land to build their priory. Although even before the Augustinians came, there is evidence that a hermitage, dedicated to St James, occupied the site, or one very nearby, that attracted hermits. Today the site is certainly at its best and quietest, as few visitors disturb its peace and tranquillity, the very peace and tranquillity that others before us had sought and found.

District Councillors' Update - December 2021

We'd like to remind people that the Hythe Community Hub, which is supported by the District Council, is there to help those who are in need. You can't visit the hub in person but you can email or phone. Email: covid-19@ageukhl.org.uk Call 01303 269602 (messages can be left outside opening hours).

On 2 December 2011 Folkestone & Hythe became the first district council in the country to commit to the Armed Force Covenant, a promise that those who serve or served in the forces and their families are treated fairly and not disadvantaged in their daily lives. Ten years on



(on 03 December to be precise), a refreshed pledge was signed by Folkestone & Hythe District Council Chairman Councillor Philip Martin and Major Peter Houlton-Hart MBE, of The 1st Battalion Royal Gurkha Rifles (RGR), at Westenhanger Castle. Last month, your District Council received the Employer Recognition Scheme Gold Award from the Ministry of Defence; this is the highest badge of honour for military support.

There's some good news about air quality in our district. The 2021 report on air quality in 2020 found no incidences of high levels of nitrogen dioxide gas at monitoring sites which means the District Council does not need to declare any Air Quality Management Areas. The Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has now formally accepted the report.


Most streetlights in Kent are owned and maintained by KCC but there is still a significant number owned by Folkestone & Hythe District Council. The District Council has decided to upgrade all its 1,063 lights to LED and transfer ownership of 340 of them to KCC. The whole project will cost £815,034 but will reduce running and maintainance costs so will save money (an estimated £2 million over 20years). Importantly it will also reduce carbon emissions.

Fly-tipping is a criminal offence and, together with Kent Police, your District Council is responsible for taking enforcement action against those who blight our countryside and towns. We are therefore pleased to report that 9 people have recently been successfully prosecuted for separate fly-tips which included sofas, beds and a mattress. All such waste can be taken for recycling at KCC's Household Waste Recycling Centres without charge or collected and disposed of properly for a small charge by the District Council. If you have evidence of fly-tipping (CCTV or eye witness accounts) do please report this to Kent Police or the District Council

We wish you all a Happy New Year and once again thank everyone who helps make our community thrive.





"IS IT TRUE?" by Colin Manvell


A few days ago, a golfing pal of mine, knowing I live in Etchinghill, asked me if I knew that about 50 years ago when there was a hospital in the grounds, now known



BRIEFING NOTE

F&HDC Housing Briefing Note

8 December 2021

Woodland Cottages, Lyminge

The purpose of this briefing note is to update you on the preliminary work we are doing around the long-term future of housing stock in Woodland Road, Lyminge.

The eight semi-detached properties were built of reinforced concrete. They are inefficient to heat and consequently have a significant carbon footprint. Built post war, they present a challenge for both long-term maintenance and to improve against the aims of our zero carbon agenda.

Their future is part of a long-term project but we have written to and visited our tenants recently to explain why we are having to take some immediate steps. Contrary to rumours, none of our tenants are being evicted and there has been no compulsory purchase of any of the houses.

We have taken the opportunity to buy back one of the properties on the open market which had previously been purchased under the Right to Buy scheme.

To have all the properties again in council ownership allows us greater flexibility when considering the future of the site. To support this flexibility, demolition notices have been served meaning that no further homes can be sold whilst their future is being decided.

Our long term aim is to provide better homes for our Folkestone & Hythe District Council tenants and we shall be continuing to keep tenants and stakeholders fully involved in all the key stages of this project.

Once the future of the properties is agreed, each tenant will be fully involved in their options – one of which could be moving back into a new home at the same location which they have been involved in designing.

The Return of the Choughs

Choughs were once an iconic species on the White Cliffs of Dover and hopefully they soon they will be again. Choughs went extinct in Kent more than 200 years ago due to changing farming practices and persecution. Legend has it that the chough got its red bill and beak following the murder of Thomas Becket when a crow flew down and walked in his blood, turning its bill and feet red and transforming into a chough.



The Kent Wildlife Trust (KWT), Wildwood Trust, English Heritage and Paradise Park, have created an aviary of Choughs at Dover Castle and this is now moving to an exciting new stage of reintroducing this wonderful bird to Kent

There has already been some great work in Cornwall and nowadays you would be pretty unlucky not to see them at the Lizard National Nature reserve on the south coast. Their recovery has been through a combination of science-led practical interventions, communities pulling together, and a hefty dollop of belief.

Chough facts:

- Choughs are a distinctive member of the crow family, easy to pick out with red beaks and legs and sounding a bit like a jackdaw that's having fun
- Our species of chough (the red-billed chough) has a wide range across Europe, North Africa and Asia, with a northern limit in Scotland and southern limit in two outlying populations in Ethiopia.
- They are known as Cornish choughs locally though the association with the county has long been recognised further afield: in Wales and Scotland during the 17th Century, where choughs would also have been common, the chough was known as the Crow of Cornwall.
- The Cornish name for chough is Palores, which means digger.
- King Arthur departed the world in the form of a chough (or so they say).





The Egrets Are Back!

The little egrets are back on Tayne Field / Well Field / the Nailbourne, at least since the first week of December - a month earlier than last year, when they were first spotted from the first week of January (see the article in the February 2021 Lyminge newsletter). They stayed until late April last time.



QUACKS AND CROAKS - The question which sex of ducks quacks?", posed in local January quiz, and the quizmaster's gleeful answer "female - of course!", caused much discussion, not all from aggrieved feminists.

Subsequent research in Bushey Ruff was inconclusive. In the flock of mallards that we observed, males seemed to outquack females if anything. The consensus among duck experts is that generally, given that sounds vary according to function and between species, females make "loud" quacks and males make "raspy" quacks.

At Middlesex University, academics have now taken the research further, discovering, according to a report published last month, that ducks have regional accents. Dr Victoria de Rijke compared quacks recorded at Spitalfields City Farm in east London and at the tranquil Trerieve Farm near Looe in Cornwall, and concluded that the



ducks had developed distinct regional accents in response to their environments. The cockney ducks had rough "shouting" quacks with short open vowels that allowed them to be heard above the din of city transport, while their Cornish cousins had gentle burrs, more like "giggles", with longer and slower vowels.

Not surprisingly, regional accents are also found in other creatures such as frogs. Amphibian expert Julia Wycherley discovered the accents while trying to find out exactly which sub-species of pool frog (Rana lessonae) had lived in East Anglia before becoming extinct. She spent much time listening to frogs' mating calls and detected three accents directly related to the frogs' genetic heritage, from ancient Iberia, Italy and the Balkans. The problem for displaced frogs is that mating can prove impossible if they make calls in the wrong language. English Nature now plans to acquire a single-source population of Balkan pool frogs in the hope that they will, one day, exchange croaks and repopulate the East Anglian wetlands. 




